Olympic Park

The plans for the new Olympic Park is based around the deprived area of Stratford in London's East End one of the most deprived areas in the UK. It focuses on the regeneration of 500 acres of land, transforming the social and sporting landscape of the capital.

Lord Coe and the London Team's vision is to build a new national athletics stadium, an athlete's village, aquatic centre and velodrome, but it also fits in the idea of a non-wasteful games, with several temporary venues to be relocated elsewhere in the UK. The plans also make use of famous landmarks and sporting venues such as the new Wembley – tennis at Wimbledon and beach volleyball, along Horse-guards Parade etc.

"Legacy" was the word used often to deliver the message - give us the Games, and one of the world's great capital cities will be transformed.
