You must be between the ages of 9 and 16.

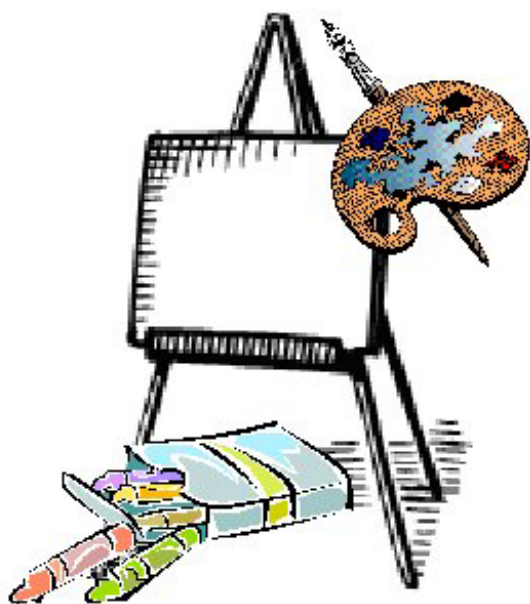
You must ask your parent(s) to sign the entry form to allow you to enter the competition.
