

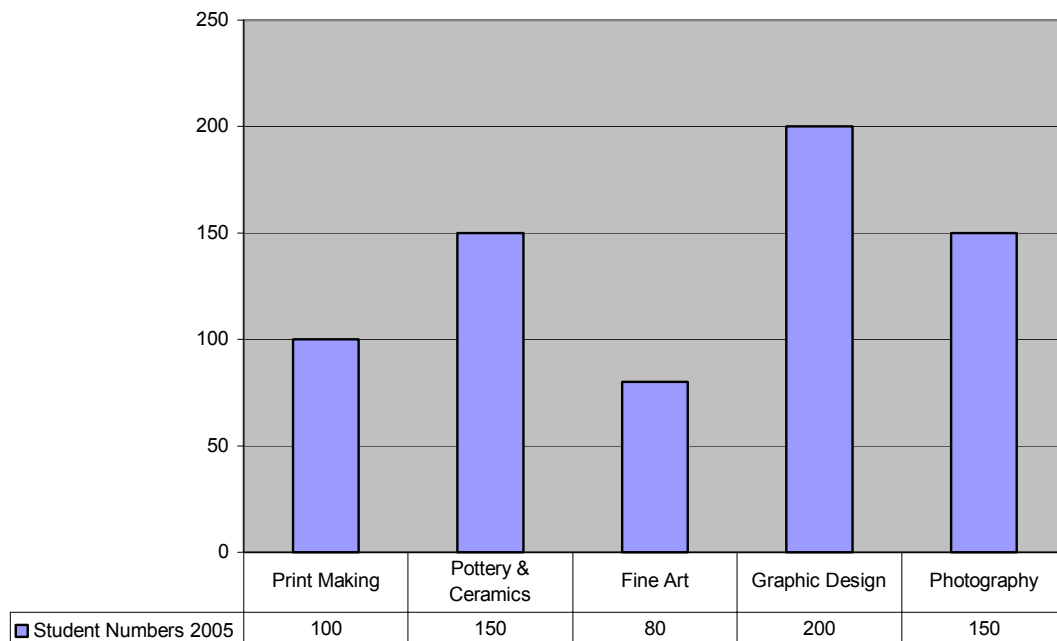

We offer a wide range of art related subjects these include print making, pottery and ceramics, fine art, graphic design and photography.

Print Making – BTEC National Diploma

- ★ Our print making facilities offer a wide variety of machinery to choose from, these include everything from screen printing and block pressing through to the latest in-house corporate quality printing both photographic and digital based.

Pottery & Ceramics - BTEC National Diploma

- ★ With our own kiln on site, running firings every day, and over 30 pot throwing wheels we are amongst the largest facility in the region.

Fine Art - BTEC National Diploma

- ★ We have 5 studios completely committed to fine art, with a major emphasis on life drawing classes we run over 10 a week, we have a range of tutors both full time and part time who teach this subject, several who exhibit in the larger galleries.

Graphic Design – BTEC National Diploma

- ★ We have 3 studios of Apple Macs and with the back up of our print making facilities offer a fully realistic commercially bias environment in which students can develop there skills effectively. We also have links with many local design agencies often running briefs on a live basis.
