  - o a glossary of difficult terms, with words emboldened in the text
  - o a space for students to write their own vocabulary and make notes
- A teacher's pack, containing:

    - three comprehension questions two in English; one in Spanish
    - four to six sentences from the Spanish text to translate into Englis
  - a versatile bank of ideas (see 'How to use') for additional reading and lisand recordings to create bespoke lessons for the students in your class

  - unce '**slow**' recording to facilitate unders'and in and vocabulary acquisi

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## **How to Use the Pack**

In the teacher's pack, there are **comprehension questions** and **translations** as set activities, which can be presented to students per story (entire resource), per charge or per activity.


