- 4. The ASP solution with explanation


A disk containing the worked solution is also enclosed with this resource.

Disk Setup

The disk contains an Access database (library.mdb) and a series of ASP files.

To install the system, the files need to be copied onto your school or college Intranet or web server (see your network manager for help with this if necessary). They can also be run on stand-alone or networked machines if they have a web server installed on them.

To start the system, open the file *index.asp*. Note that you need to open it through your web browser; e.g. the address will be something like *http://intranet/asplibrary/index.asp*. You should then see this page:



You may also want to make the Access database and the ASP files available separately to students to look at as you cannot look at the code through the web server.
